Scholarship Requirements and Application

Applicant must:

1. Be a U.S. citizen, high school senior, graduating with the current graduating class, **from the Forrest, Lamar, Jones & Perry County areas**. (Grand Bank employees or children of employees or the Board of Directors are excluded from this scholarship.)
2. Have a minimum 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
3. Must provide official transcript in sealed envelope.
4. Register as a full-time (at least 12 hours) student within the next 6 months following date of graduation at any **Mississippi** junior or senior college (proof of enrollment must be provided to Bank before funds are distributed).
5. Complete the attached scholarship application and attach the required **3 letters of recommendation**. The letters of recommendation should come from the following individuals:
 - a. Guidance Counselor and/or Teacher; and
 - b. Leader of a community organization in which the student participates; and
 - c. Any other non-family adult of the student’s choosing (i.e. employer or religious leader).
6. **Turn in the complete application including all attachments to any Grand Bank location by 4:30 p.m. on March 15, 2018**. (Please note that incomplete, late and/or mailed applications will *not* be considered.)
7. Type or print clearly all information.
8. Put Name at the top of each page of your application (especially on any additional pages containing your essay answers).
9. Read and sign the disclosure.
10. Be willing to participate in an interview with the scholarship committee.
